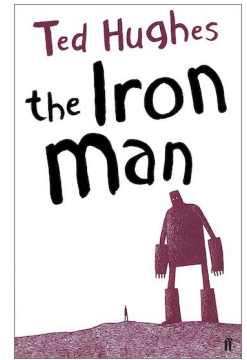




Welcome back

The children will need:

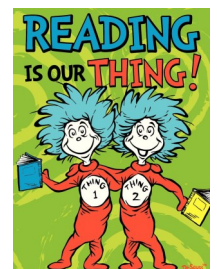
- Blue shorts
