## Year 4 topics for Spring Term



Welcome to this half term in Year 4.


In literacy, the class will be continuing to read How To Train Your Dragon by Cressida Cowell. They will consider the characters, the plot and the themes of the story. They will be planning, writing and exploring the features of a setting description based on information from the text.



In maths, the class will be learning about fractions and decimals. They will be finding out about improper and equivalent fractions. They will think about tenths and hundredths and learn how to divide a one or two digit number by ten and a hundred. They will continue to develop their recall of multiplication and division facts based on times tables up to  $12 \times 12$ .

In history, the class topic this term will be the Anglo-Saxons. The class will learn where the Anglo-Saxons came from and why the settled here. They will also learn about Anglo-Saxon settlements and how the country was divided into different kingdoms.

In art - the class will be learning about 3D and collage. They will learn about the work of Alberto Giacometti. They will use their ideas to create their own artwork.



PE will be on Tuesday afternoons. The focus for this half term will be athletics.

In RE, the class will be thinking about the question — Is forgiveness always possible for Christians?

In music, the class will be continuing to learn how to play the recorder and will be taking part in a performance at the Victoria Hall on the 5th March. Please return permission slips to school ASAP (via email or paper copy-whichever is more convenient).

In PSHE, the class will be learning about physical health and mental wellbeing. They will consider what is means to have a healthy body and why sleep is so important.
