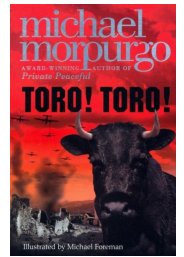


Year 4 topics for Summer Term



Welcome back to our last term in Year 4.

In literacy, we will continue reading *Toro, Toro* by Michael Morpurgo. We will work on writing two pieces of extended writing including a piece of narrative writing and a discussion.

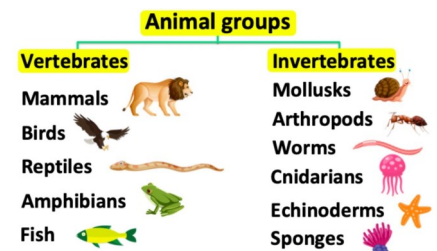


In maths, when learning about geometry, Year 4 will find out about angles and turns, triangles and quadrilaterals and symmetry. They will also learn about position and direction. In statistics, they will learn how to interpret charts and line graphs. They will continue to develop their recall of multiplication facts based on times tables up to 12 x 12.



In Geography the topic this term will be Spain. The class will locate Spain on a map of Europe and the World. They will learn about human and physical features of Spain and compare the Spanish climate to that of the UK. They will learn about the eight points on a compass and use 4 figure grid references to locate places on a map.

In Science, the topic will be 'Living things and their habitats'. The class will learn about vertebrates and invertebrates. They will learn about classification and how to use classification keys. They will also consider the changes to a habitat if the environment changes.



PE— we will continue with our swimming lessons and athletics activities in preparation for sports day. Please come to school on Thursdays wearing your PE kit.

In RE, we will be thinking about the question- Do people need to go to church to show they are Christians?

In D&T, we will be learning about food and nutrition. We will be making a chick-pea curry and Mexican pasties.

The Year 4 times table test will take place at the start of this half term. Please encourage your child to practise their tables at home.

Homework will be set on class dojo. This will include regular reading, weekly spellings and the optional tasks.
